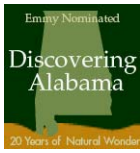

**AWF's Summer Conservation Education Workshop #4:**

**Discovering Alabama's Big Outdoors with Literature  
(July 19 & 20, 2011)**

**Workshop Description:** Come learn about Alabama's "Big Outdoors" while having fun making connections between nature and children's literature through hands-on inquiry based activities. This workshop will focus on several nature-themed children's books and the concepts they incorporate as well as hands-on, inquiry based activities that make real-world connections for children between literature and nature.
