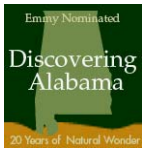

Discovering Alabama by "Going Native" (July 12 & 13, 2011)

Workshop Description: Come spend time with us as you learn about Alabama's natural diversity and its ecosystems.
