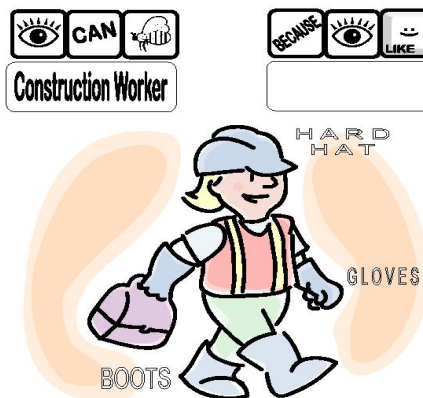

I CAN BE

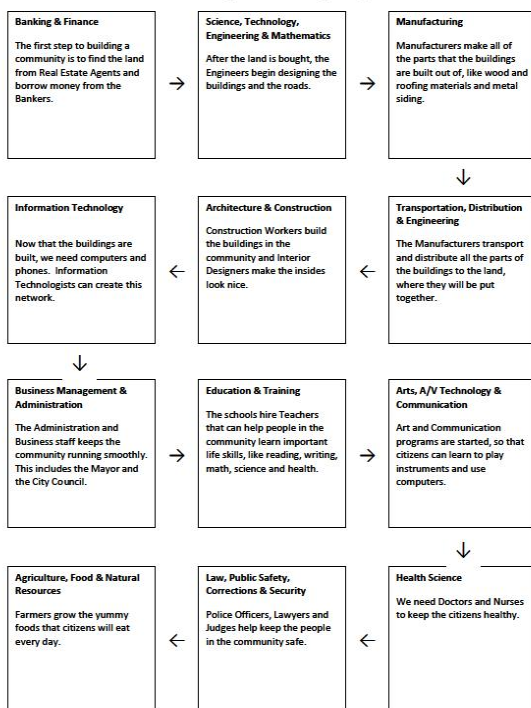
In partnership with the South Alabama Workforce Development Council (SAWDC), *I Can Be* will introduce kindergarten through second grade teachers to a workforce development tool as the first step in the SAWDC Workforce continuum, the SAWDC coloring book, "I Can Be." The coloring book, created by Exploreum education staff and industry partners, introduces career paths, teamwork and the concept of an integrated community while reinforcing reading skills, vocabulary development and handwriting.
